Description of the location

Purpose built surgery, owned by the Practice on land with a 125 year lease from Norwich City Council. The surgery provides consulting rooms for four doctors, a nurse practitioner, practice nurse and healthcare assistant with plans to build a two consulting room extension for which funding has recently been approved.

The Surgery is sited centrally to its practice area, serving a population mainly living in Lakenham, Tuckswood, Town Close, Eaton Rise, and Trowse. The patient list at Tuckswood has a significant number of young families and the very elderly. The surgery looks after a nursing home (The Hawthorns), a residential home (Corton House) and housing with care (The Great Hospital and Harriett Court) as well as a number of sheltered housing units. We also provide general medical cover for Newmarket House, a specialist residential unit for eating disorders.

Description of the location

Rented ex-commercial building converted to a GP surgery in 1996 to provide consulting rooms for five Doctors, two Nurse Practitioners, a Practice Nurse and two HCA's. A new building project on a different site nearby is in progress. Access is for the high street through double doors in to the main waiting room. All rooms are on one level and are all accessible for wheel chair users. A significant number of the patients registered at Gurney Surgery live within the Mancroft, Sewell and Thorpe Hamlet district wards. There is a large elderly population and a significant number of patients with alcohol and drug abuse and mental health problems. The surgery looks after Bowthorpe Care Village and several retirement flat complexes and sheltered housing at Doughty's Hospital.
